Scouting simply would not exist without the enthusiasm of our adult helpers. With this in mind we encourage you and your family members (over 18), to lend a hand. We know that life can be busy, so we're all about flexibility; You can give as much of your time as you choose. We want you to experience the fun and adventure that scouting offers young people, at the same time as helping our scout group thrive. Being part of scouting is great fun and it goes without saying that helping young people can be one of the most rewarding things you can do.

Whether you can spare an hour a week, a month or a term, it's far easier to provide exciting activities at our meetings if we have your support. You may think that you have nothing to offer but you'd be surprised!

We fully understand that you may not be able to help on a regular basis which is why we operate a rota. Our rota means you can make a difference and help without having to do so every week, if lots of people are on the rota then your commitment may only be once or twice a term.





As a helper on our rota you just need to turn up on the days you have agreed and lend a hand. No preparation or special skills are required. You will be asked to assist with games and craft activities and support the young people to participate in activities. We provide lots of support and guidance and you will be a valuable member of our team.

The safety of our members is our first priority so we will have to collect a few details from you and if you help more than once a month you will need undertake a Disclosure and Barring Service Check (DBS check).
