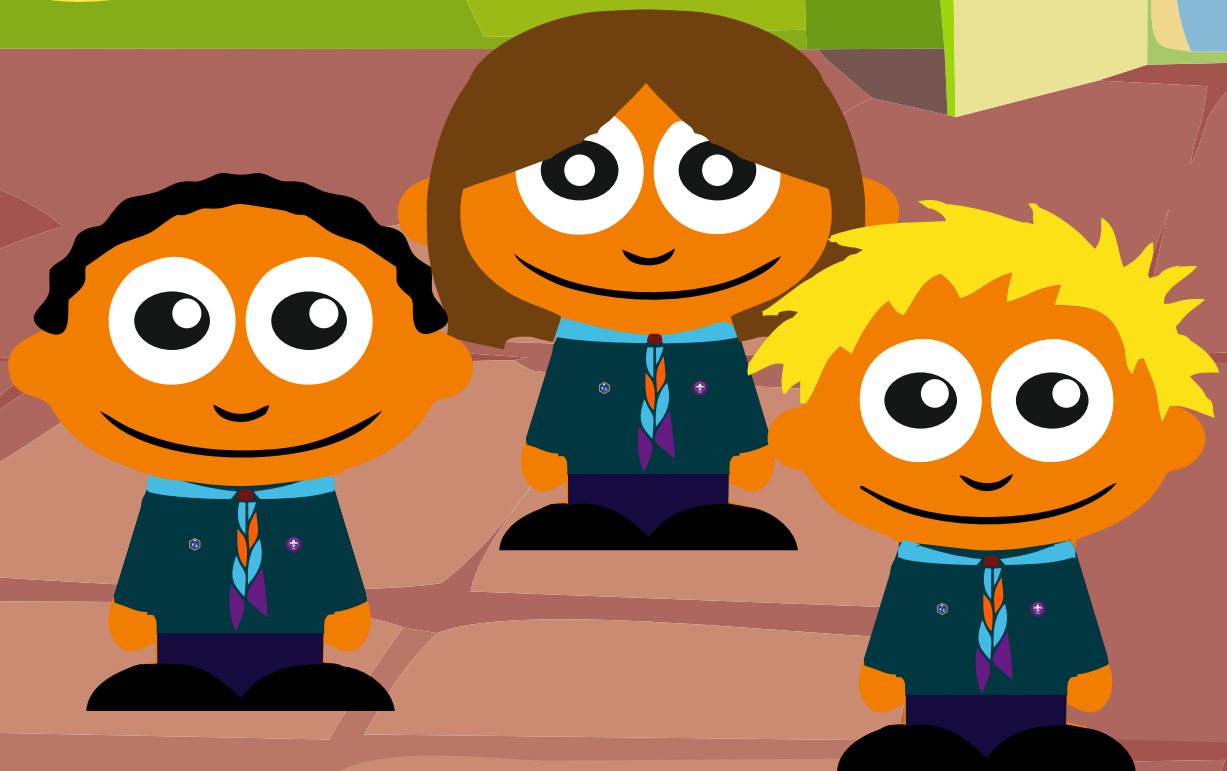

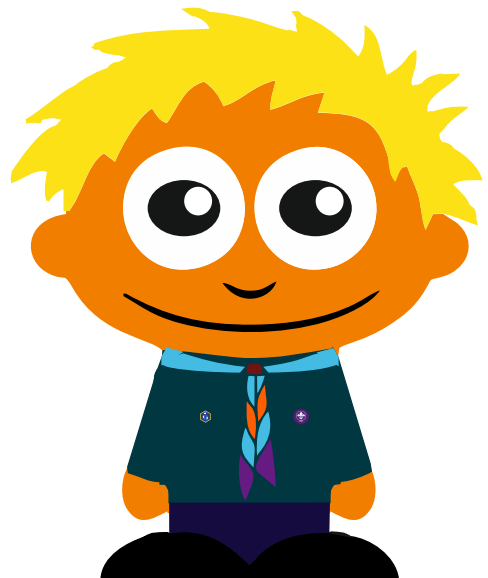

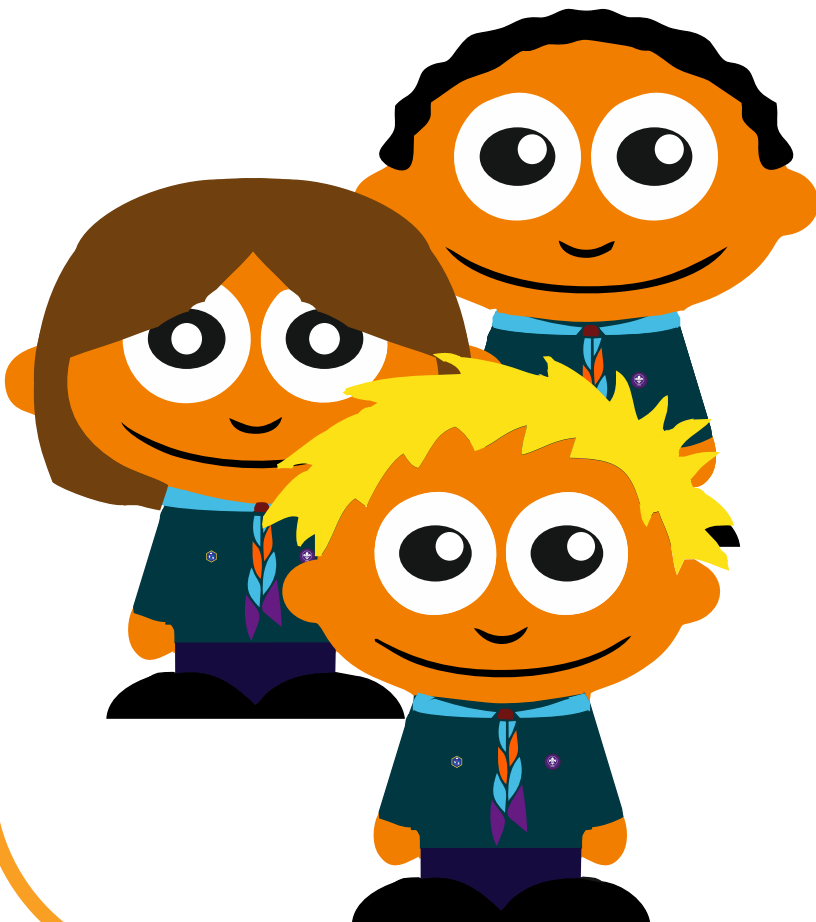

When you and your friends are at cubs you will spend time in a small group called a six. Your six has a sixer, who helps organise your six.

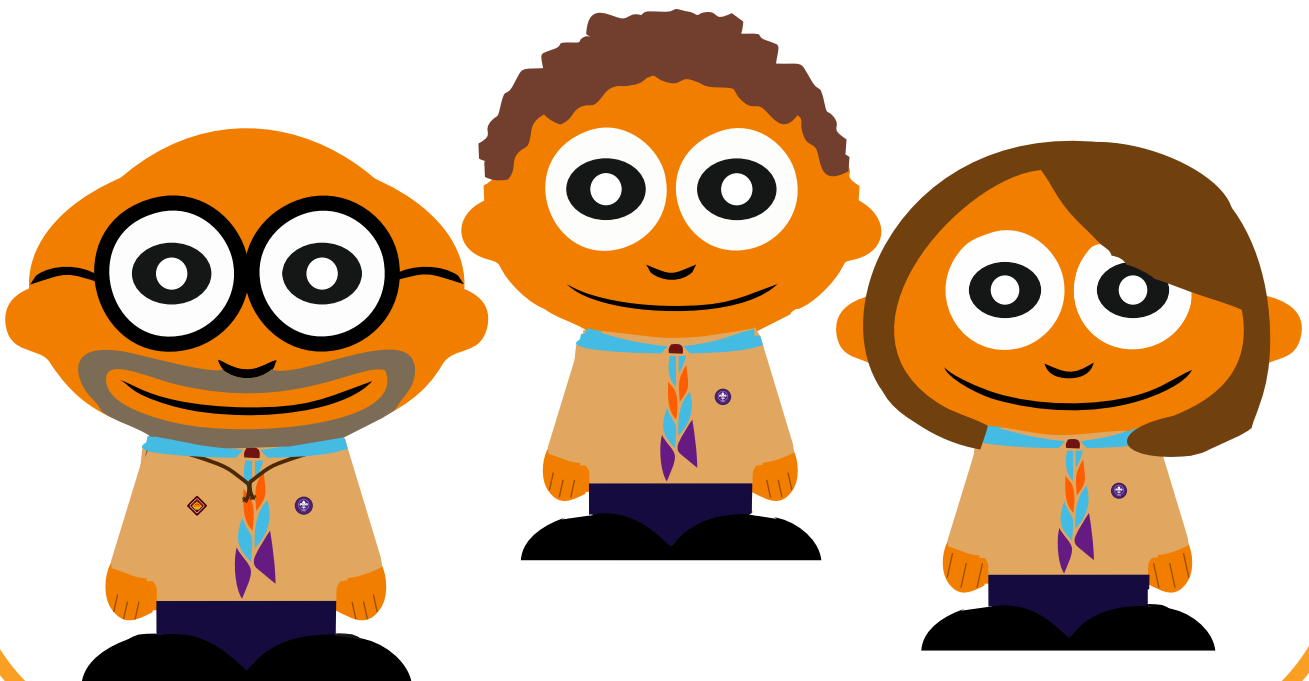
