You will need ...



- Glue sticks
- Scrap card
- Coloured pens, pencils, or crayons
- Any available craft materials (for example, tissue paper, pipe cleaners, lolly sticks)
- A cardboard box (shoe boxes work well)
- Collections – like Pokémon Trading Cards, coins, stamps, cars, action figures or memorabilia

A message from Professor Magnolia, the renowned academic and discoverer of Pokémon

Your collection has been chosen as the star attraction for a museum. Before it is constructed in full, create a model to show how the exhibition will be laid out.

Prepare a miniature exhibition of curiosities. These could be things you've collected, like Pokémon Trading Cards or toys, or things you've made, like Pokémon origami. The museum will feature exhibitions from within and beyond the Pokémon world, so you could also showcase collectables like coins, music memorabilia, books, stamps or something else which interests you.

Build a shoe box museum

1. Before starting your model, think about how you will lay out the exhibition:
 - Do the objects need to tell a story?
 - Do the objects need to be displayed in a certain order?
 - What information about the objects will you share? Captions, films, signs?
 - How will visitors find their way around your exhibition?
 - How can you make the experience exciting for visitors?
2. Begin construction of your mini exhibition, making it as exciting and eye-catching as you can.
3. Once your exhibition is complete think about what you might change or do differently next time?
