



South London Scouts' Delegation to The UK Youth Forums - T&Cs

Objective: To ensure that the County can effectively and fairly select our delegation to represent Greater London South Scouts known as South London Scouts at the UK Youth Forum.

The Idea:

The UK Youth Forum was introduced by the UK Youth Team to Youth Leads in Regional Calls held in September 2024. This idea was further communicated with the Region at the Team London Day in October 2024. Our County Delegation was confirmed in the All Member Email in December 2024, along with guidance on selecting participants for the delegation.

Our Delegation:

The South London Scouts delegation to the UK Youth Forum will consist of the following members:

- 2 Scouts
- 2 Explorers
- 2 Adult Volunteers (at least one of whom must be aged 18-24)
- The County Youth Lead will be one of the adult volunteers, as approved by the Board.

Advertising:

The opportunity to apply for the UK Youth Forum delegation will be shared via the YouShape pages on our County website, as well as through emails and social media platforms to ensure all members are aware of this exciting opportunity.

Application:

All applicants are required to submit a short video answering the questions outlined in the information pack. This video should demonstrate your enthusiasm for the UK Youth Forum and your ability to represent South London Scouts.

Selection:

The selection of the delegation members will be conducted by the County Youth Lead and the County Lead Volunteer. Applicants will be assessed based on their responses in the video and their overall suitability to represent the County at the UK Youth Forum.

Offer:

Successful applicants will receive an offer to join the delegation. Additionally, there will be other opportunities to get involved with Youth Shaped Scouting within the County, and all applicants will be encouraged to participate in these opportunities.

Commitment:

Selected delegates must commit to attending the UK Youth Forum event on [Insert Date] and must be available for the entire day. The group will travel to and from the event together. We also ask that you attend the Scout/Explorer Youth Forums in advance of the event to hear ideas and perspectives from across the County. This will help ensure that you are well-prepared to represent the views of all Scouts and Explorers on the day.

What We Will Provide:

- Event Entry: We will cover the entrance to the UK Youth Forum.
- Travel: Travel to and from a central London meeting point will be arranged and provided by us.
- Lunch: We will provide lunch for all delegates on the day of the event.
- County Scarf: Delegates will receive a County scarf to wear at the UK Youth Forum.

Behaviour Expectations:

- Delegates are expected to represent South London Scouts with respect and professionalism, adhering to the Scout Promise and Law throughout the event.
- Any behaviour that is deemed inappropriate or contrary to the values of Scouting may result in removal from the delegation.

Cancellation/Withdrawal:

- If you are unable to attend after being selected, please inform the County Youth Lead as soon as possible so that another candidate may be offered a place.

Conclusion:

We are excited to offer this incredible opportunity to represent South London Scouts at the UK Youth Forum and encourage all eligible members to apply. We believe this experience will provide valuable insights and opportunities for personal development, and we are looking forward to selecting a strong delegation to take part in this important event.
